Regina Minor Football Alumni Entrance Award for Football Student Athletes

Regina Minor Football is offering one, \$5000 scholarship to an RMF Alumni student graduating from high school. This scholarship is available to all football student athletes registered to play for the Regina Rams or the Regina Thunder upon entrance to their first year of studies at either University of Regina or Saskatchewan Polytechnic. Student athletes must continue to play and attend school in Regina for the scholarship to continue.

This scholarship is payable over five years. \$1000 is awarded each year; \$500 at the beginning of each semester for a total of ten semesters. **A \$500 cheque will be issued at the beginning of each semester, if all requirements continue to be met. If a student fails to meet the criteria at any time, the scholarship is forfeited for the remainder of the student athlete's eligibility:**

Criteria:

- The student must have played in RMF for at least two seasons. RMF Spring League does qualify as a season.
- Students must have taken, or be enrolled in, the following high school classes, and have maintained a minimum 70% average in:
 - ELA 20
 - ELA A30 and ELA B30
 - One 20 Level Math
 - One 30 Level Math
 - Canadian Studies 30
 - One 20 or 30 level social science
 - One 20 level science
 - One 30 level science
- The student must submit a copy of the official transcript from the Ministry of Education.
- Confirmation of enrollment must be provided to RMF by August 21, 2016.
- Scholarship will be awarded Sept. 1st annually.
- Student must be enrolled in a minimum 60% Course load (3 classes) in the first year of a degree program at the University of Regina or in a certificate or diploma program at Saskatchewan Polytechnic.
- Based on high school qualifications a \$500.00 cheque will be issued Sept. 1st.
- Upon completion of the student's first semester and each subsequent semester of post-secondary education, the student must submit the required paperwork to confirm all requirements were met.
- Student must maintain a minimum semester average of 70% in order to retain the scholarship. Failure to sustain the 70% semester average will result in a complete termination of the scholarship.
- Cheques will be issued Jan. 1st and Sept. 1st based on the previous semester's grades.
