<u>Procedure for Criminal Record Checks/Respect in Sport/Making Head Way in</u> Football

Criminal Record Check

Anyone who will be involved in team operations with an RMF team in 2023 that has not handed in a Criminal Record Check (CRC) in 2021, 2022 or 2023 is required to submit a CRC this year. CRC are then valid for three years.

Note: They must be a Criminal Record Check with a vulnerable Sector Query

****You can no longer drop in to apply for Criminal Record Checks in person****

You must either apply online or make an appointment online to go to Regina Police Service to obtain your CRC. It may take up to a week to get an appointment so make sure you apply asap. They are recommending Online applications only.

- You must reside in the City of Regina.
- You must have 2 pieces of identification (one with your full date of birth). At least one piece of photo identification.
- It is recommended the RMF Specific Police Check Wavier Letter (attached) is presented when applying for your CRC.
- There is a \$10 Fee for this.
