Youth Coach Policy

1. Coaches (head coaches and assistant coaches) must be at least 18 years of age by the coaching application deadline.
 - a. Head coaches that want to have a youth assistant coach must fill in a Youth Coaching Application Form (attached) and submit it with their Team Personnel Info Form to rmfcoach@sasktel.net by July 7, 2023 for review.
 - b. In order to have a youth assistant coach, the youth coach must be under the supervision of an NCCP certified mentor coach (either the head coach or the coordinator in charge of the youth coach's position group) – minimum Introduction to Competition – Position Coach certification.

2. Youth coaches must be at least 14 years of age by the coaching application deadline.
 - a. Youth coaches are limited to position coach roles (not coordinators).
 - b. Youth coaches may not run drills involving collisions without an adult coach being directly involved (coaching/supervising).
 - c. Youth coaches must be at least two years older than the player age group they are coaching as of the coaching application deadline (atom coaches must be at least 13; pee wee coaches must be at least 15; bantam coaches must be at least 17)

3. Youth Coaches must have Safe Contact Certification.

4. All Youth Coaches must be listed on the Team Personnel Info Form. Coaches 17 years of age and under do not need a Criminal Record Check.
